Heather Gardner is currently the Executive Director of the Central Texas Coalition for Life, an organization dedicated to helping women in crisis pregnancies find loving alternatives to abortion.

Previously, she served as the Director of Communications for the Brazos Valley Coalition for Life in Bryan, Texas, birth place of 40 Days for Life and where former Planned Parenthood director, Abby Johnson, had her conversion.

Heather received degrees in Sociology and Vocal Performance at Texas A&M University. Heather's service for the Coalition for Life includes recruiting and training Prayer Volunteers and Sidewalk Counselors, coordinating church/community outreach & education, and interacting with the team of leaders that help coordinate the 40 Days for Life prayer campaigns.

Over the last decade, Heather has trained over 2,000 volunteers (locally, nationally and internationally) to be Sidewalk Counselors, including in the states of Texas, Kansas, Washington, Pennsylvania, Nebraska, New Mexico, California, Connecticut, Arizona and for cities in Romania, New Zealand and Columbia. She has also trained several hundred volunteers to be pregnancy center client advocates. Heather spends regular time on the sidewalks outside abortion facilities reaching out to women and men, and praying for an end to abortion.
